Malaysia Research Assessment Instrument

The MyRA* (Malaysia Research Assessment Instrument) evaluation is designed to measure research, development and commercialization activities (R&D&C) at various institutes of higher education (both public and private that are designated as universities, overseas campus branches and university colleges) in Malaysia.

The assessment is based on three main aspects, namely input, process and output. In return, this three covers 8 main criteria:

- Quantity and Quality of the Researcher
- Quantity of Postgraduate Candidates
- Innovation

- Makes major contributions and innovations in the development of their respective professions
- Shows evidence of national and international recognition of excellence through consultancy activities
- Where applicable, has obtained certification by relevant bodies

- Demonstrates excellence in institutional leadership
- Leads and empowers institution to serve the community and the nation to achieve national agenda
- Demonstrates good leadership attributes
